FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By Decision No. 67954, dated October 6, 1964, in this proceeding the Commission, among other things, authorized Merchants Express of California to merge into Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Company which, as the surviving corporation, was granted authority to change its name to Walkup Merchants Company.

The Petition for Modification shows that subsequent to the issuance of said decision, applicants' respective Boards of Directors determined that it was preferable to change the name of the surviving corporation to Walkup's Merchants Express. Applicants therefore request modification of said Decision No. 67954 by deleting references to Walkup Merchants Company and inserting Walkup's Merchants Express where appropriate.

The Commission has considered this Petition for Modification and finds that the proposed change in the surviving corporation's name would not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the Petition for Modification should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 67954, dated October 6, 1964, is hereby amended by substituting Walkup's Merchants Express for Walkup Merchants Company wherever the latter appears in said decision.

2. The tariff filings required by Ordering Paragraph 5 of such Decision No. 67954 may be made effective on one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

3. The effective date of this First Supplemental Order is the date hereof.
