ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY John L. Montgomery, doing business as Brisbane Transportation Company, requests authority to suspend passenger stage service between Brisbane on the one hand, and San Francisco and South San Francisco on the other hand, until November 1, 1965. The authority was granted by Decision No. 67198, dated May 12, 1964, in the above-numbered application. The service was operated for a short time, but it is stated by applicant that, at present, there is insufficient passenger traffic potential to generate the amount of revenue required to cover the costs of operation. Applicant is of the opinion, however, that the trend of growth in Brisbane is such that the authorized operation may become economically feasible within a year's time. The City of Brisbane has been notified and has indicated no objection to the requested suspension. After consideration, the Commission finds that the granting of the suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. IT IS ORDERED THAT: 1. The operating authority granted by Decision No. 67198 in Application No. 46246 is hereby suspended until November 1, 1965. - 1 -

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, John L. Montgomery shall amend his tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
