ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Hollow Rod of California requests that its certificated authority as a petroleum irregular route carrier be suspended until June 30, 1965.

It is alleged that applicant is presently in the process of dissolution and that its operating equipment is being leased to another carrier.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operating authority acquired by Decision No. 58597 dated June 16, 1959, in Application No. 41099, is hereby suspended to and including June 30, 1965.

2. All effective tariff schedules of Hollow Rod of California filed pursuant to the certificate acquired by the decision referred

to above are hereby suspended until June 30, 1965. Suspension supplements to tariff schedules so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
