OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 68465, entered today in Case No. 5438, et al., the Commission found that the Los Angeles and San Francisco Territories described in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 8, 11-A and 12 should be revised by designating them in terms of the new metropolitan zones established in Distance Table No. 5. In order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, the decision provided that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 11-A be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 11-A (Appendix A to Decision No. 50114, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 20, 1965, First Revised Page 13 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than February 20, 1965; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if

filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rules authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rules published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 80114, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
