ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 68129 dated October 27, 1964, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of John E. Duckett unless he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to the order requesting public hearing or shall have amended his tariff to comply with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders in which event the effective date of the order would be stayed.

On November 27 and 30, 1964, Agent C. R. Nickerson filed tariff revisions listing John E. Duckett as a participant in various tariffs effective December 28, 1964, and January 2, 1965.¹ Inasmuch as the carrier now has on file with the Commission tariffs that are in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders, Decision No. 68129, supra, will be vacated.
