ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Tony S. Caruso, doing business as Caruso Produce Express, has been suspended since October 2, 1963, for failure to maintain the required tariffs in effect.¹ Caruso's tariffs were canceled by his tariff publishing agent effective August 15, 1963, and he has not filed the required tariffs since that date.²

Tony S. Caruso not having the required tariffs on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by

¹ The certificate authorizes service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh fruits, fresh vegetables and berries, including mushrooms, between Los Angeles Basin points and San Francisco Bay area points and intermediate points.

² The tariffs are Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Scope of Operations and Participating Carrier Tariff No. 100, Cal.P.U.C. No. 3, Distance Table No. 4, Cal.P.U.C. 15 (J. L. Beeler, Agent, Series), and Local, Joint and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 18-B, Cal.P.U.C. No. 17 (J. L. Beeler, Agent, Series).

Tony S. Caruso by Decision No. 63990 dated July 24, 1962, in Application No. 44568 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Tony S. Caruso or to mail a certified copy thereof to Tony S. Caruso at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Tony S. Caruso or after the above mailing to Tony S. Caruso, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
