ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The highway common carrier certificate of public convenience and necessity of John R. Webb, doing business as Webb Truck Co., has been under suspension since December 6, 1964, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required freight tariffs. The suspension was effected by Decision No. 68213 dated November 10, 1964, in this proceeding.

On November 24, 1964, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, filed tariff revisions listing John R. Webb as a participant in various tariffs effective December 26, 1964.¹ Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 68213, supra, will be vacated.

No. 22, Exception Sheet No. 1-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 18, and Local Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal.P.U.C. No. 15.
