ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Readymix Concrete Company, Ltd., requests that its certificated authority as a cement carrier be suspended for a period of one year. Said authority was granted by Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 34.

It is alleged that the sole shareholder of the parent corporation has passed away and his estate is in the process of pursuing an orderly course of reorganizing his corporate and personal affairs.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operating authority granted to Readymix Concrete Company, Ltd., by Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 34, is hereby suspended until January 1, 1966.
2. All effective tariff schedules of Readymix Concrete Company, Ltd., filed pursuant to the certificate granted by Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 34, are hereby suspended until January 1, 1966.

Suspension supplements to tariff schedules so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
