ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 64086, dated August 1, 1962, in this proceeding, John Hugh Morris was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel for the transportation of persons between Requa and Roach Creek and all intermediate points upon and along the natural course of the Klamath River.

William S. Boyd, Jr., attorney for John Hugh Morris, has informed the Commission that the total weight of the boat which Morris operates is under five tons net and requests, on Morris' behalf, that the certificate be revoked.<sup>1</sup>

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. The requested revocation should be granted.

<sup>1</sup> Section 238(a) of the Public Utilities Code excludes from Commission regulation water craft propelled by steam, gas, fluid naphtha, electricity, or other motive power under the burden of five tons net register.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel granted to John Hugh Morris by Decision No. 64-086, dated August 1, 1962, in Application No. 44604, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon John Hugh Morris, or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon John Hugh Morris or after the above mailing to John Hugh Morris, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
