ORDER DENYING EXTENSION OF TIME AND PROVIDING FOR TIME PAYMENT OF FINE

Respondent has requested an extension of the effective date of the order in Decision No. 68204, and that respondent be allowed to pay fine assessed at the rate of \$500 per month.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the request for extension of the effective date of the order in Decision No. 68204 is denied.

The fine of \$2,500 imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 68204 may be paid in five monthly installments, \$500 to be paid not later than February 15, 1965 and \$500 to be paid not later than the fifteenth day of each of the four succeeding months.

In all other respects Decision No. 68204 shall remain in full force and effect.
