ORDER RESCINDING ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT


Decision No. 68309 dated November 30, 1964, provided for revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Clinton G. Reeder, a cement carrier, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required freight tariff, unless before the effective date of said order there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of the order would be stayed. By letter dated December 29, 1964, the attorney for Clinton G. Reeder filed a written response requesting public hearing, thereby staying the Commission's order.


On December 22, 1964, Leland C. Smith, Agent, filed tariff revisions listing Clinton G. Reeder as a participant in Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Local Freight Tariff No. 14, Cal.P.U.C. No. 6. Inasmuch as the required tariff is now on file, Decision No. 68309, supra, will be rescinded.


IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68309 dated November 30, 1964, in Resolution No. 13825, Sub. No. 11, is hereby rescinded.
