SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 68074 in this proceeding, Avila Water Company was authorized, among other things, to issue a note or notes in the aggregate sum of not to exceed \$50,000 plus 6½ percent interest in order to finance some improvements and additions to its water plant. The order provided that such note or notes should be issued on or before December 31, 1964.

By letter dated January 4, 1965, applicant has informed the Commission that the construction of its new water supply line has been interrupted because of construction of U. S. Freeway Route 101 in that area by the Division of Highways. It stated that construction of the water facilities will be resumed as soon as the freeway construction work will permit.

Applicant does not desire to borrow the necessary funds until it can resume construction of water facilities. It requests the Commission to extend, until June 30, 1965, the time within which it may issue the note or notes.

By an additional letter dated January 5, 1965, applicant has requested an extension of time to July 8, 1965, for filing the comprehensive map required by ordering paragraph 7 of the decision, because the actual location of certain facilities will not be known until freeway construction has progressed further.

> The relief sought is reasonable; therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

substituting the words "June 30, 1965" in place of the words "December 31, 1964".

2. Ordering paragraph 7 of said Decision No. 68074 is amended by substituting the words "By July 8, 1965" in place of the words "Within sixty days after the effective date of this order".

3. In all other respects, said Decision No. 68074 shall remain in full force and effect.
