ORDER OF REVOCATION

Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc., requests that its operating authority as a petroleum irregular route carrier be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificates of public convenience and necessity acquired by Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc., by Decisions Nos. 55530 and 56744 dated September 10, 1957 and May 27, 1958, in Applications Nos. 39367 and 40006, respectively, as amended by Decision No. 60902 dated October 18, 1960, in Application No. 42589, are hereby revoked.
2. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc., from its tariffs on file with this Commission, said cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records, and to

mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc.,
Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
