## OPINTON AND ORDER

Alma Nae Marsh, doing business as Felix Viarsh Transfer, bolds radjal highway comon carrier, highway contract carrier, household goods carrier and city carrier permits. Decision No. 66727, dated January 28, 1964, in Application No. 46074 , authorized der to assess rates and charges in cents per hour or per plece as named in Ninfmum Rate Tariff No, 4-B (used househola goods) in ileu of the minum rates otherwise applicable as set forth in vinimum Rate Tariff No. 2 in connection with the transportation of property for She Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, Western Electric Company and Radio Corporation of America. The current authorfty is scheduled to expire February 1, 1965. By this appILcation, she seeks renewal of this authority.

Applicant states tinat, at all times since the granting of tiee prior authority, she has performed service for the shippers all as alleged in the previous application and as set forth in Decision No. 66727, and all of the conditions under which the services were performed have remained the same.

[^0]Data furnished by applicant indicate that the transportation involved bas been profitable and reasonably may be expected to be profitable in the future.

A copy of the application was served on California Trucking issociation on or about December 2, 1964. No objection to Its befng grantec has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Comission finds, that the proposed rates are reasonable for the transportation in question. a public hearing is not necessary. The application, as amended, should be granted. However, because the conditions involved herein may change at any time, the authority will be made to expire at the end of one year. In view of the impending expiration date of the current authority, the order which follows will be made effective February 1, 1965.

IT IS ORDERED that:
I. Aima Mae Marsh, coing business as Felix Marsh Transfer, Is hereby authorized to quote and assess rates and charges in the units of measurement set forth in Itemsins. 330 and 340 of Minimum Rate Tariff N. $4-B$ and no lower than the rates and charges named in those items, in lieu of the minimum rates per 100 pounds specified in Minfmum Rate Tariff No. 2, in connection with the transportation of property for The Pactific Telephone and Telegraph Company, Westerm Electric Company and Radio Corporation of America:
2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after February 1, 2965, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 66727 arc shall expire with February $1,1966$.

This order shall become effective February 1, p 965.
