(Gas) OPINION Southern California Gas Company, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Cabazon, California, permitting the installation, maintenance, and use of a gas distribution and transmission system in the streets of said city. The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit "A", was granted by the city on September 8, 1964 in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937, was accepted by applicant on September 16, 1964, became effective October 8, 1964 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to 2 percent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 percent of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise. The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been \$121.34, which amount does not include costs incident to this application. -1The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
