## ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 67247

Decision No. 67247, dated May 19, 1964, amended the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to applicants to include additional operative rights. The decision ordered applicants to file tariffs, in triplicate, within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of the order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public. Decision No. 68004, dated October 13, 1964, denied a petition for rehearing filed by protestants on May 29, 1964, and thereby extended the final date on which tariffs could be made effective to February 10, 1965.

By letter dated January 27, 1965, applicants request that the final date on which tariffs may be made effective be extended to April 1, 1965. The letter states that applicants' tariff publishing agent did not take into account the requirement of thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public in calculating the final date on which tariffs could be filed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph (b) of Decision No. 67247, as amended by Decision No. 68004, is hereby modified to read as follows:

"(b) Within one hundred eighty days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office."

In all other respects Decision No. 67247, as amended by Decision No. 68004, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
