ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The highway common carrier certificate of public convenience and necessity of Ben Stone has been under suspension since November 12, 1964, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required freight classification. The suspension was effected by Decision No. 68098 dated October 20, 1964, in this proceeding.

On December 9, 1964, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, filed Supplement 11 to its National Motor Freight Classification A-7 (CAL) listing Ben Stone as a participant in said classification effective February 10, 1965. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 68098, supra, will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68098 dated October 20, 1964, in Application No. 36198, is hereby vacated and set aside.

The effective date of this order shall be February 10, 1965.
