ORDER OF SUSPENSION

United House Sales has filed a petition seeking rehearing of Decisions Nos. 68359, 68360, 68361 and 68362 dated December 15, 1964, in the above proceedings. The Commission, by its order dated January 5, 1965, stayed the operative effect of the above decisions.

As information to the carriers and other parties affected, a suspension supplement to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16 should be issued. In order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, the other minimum rate tariffs should be amended by separate orders.

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16 (Appendix B of Decision No. 68359) is hereby amended by incorporating
