ORDER AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 13821

Ex parte Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 51, granted applicant a "grandfather" cement carrier certificate. The certificate includes all counties requested in the application except Inyo, Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo Counties. Freight bills attached to the application showed that applicant had subhailed cement into these three counties within the "grandfather period".

The Commission has received a letter from the applicant, dated January 9, 1965, in which he requests that the cement carrier certificate issued to him be amended to include the Counties of Inyo, Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo. He pointed out that the Commission has granted a "grandfather" cement carrier certificate to Wm. H. Shatto, Inc., which includes counties in which Shatto had proved operations as a subhauler only during the "grandfather period" (Decision No. 68397, dated December 22, 1964, in Application No. 46118, et al.).

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Sub. No. 51 on page 6 of the attachment to Resolution No. 13821 be amended to read as follows:

"51. A-46518, T-56,724, Kenneth C. Fairburn, Fresno, Kern, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, Ventura, Inyo, Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
