SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 64983, dated February 19, 1963, Victor G. Tahan was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in Tract No. 1886, Fresno County.

Ordering paragraph 3 of the decision requires that applicant shall have provided for the reasonable continuation of an adequate supply of water in case of failure of the single source of supply when the number of customers reaches 20, or within one year after the date service was first rendered to the public, whichever is earlier.

By letter dated January 14, 1965, applicant requests that the requirements of ordering paragraph 3 be rescinded. It is stated that only eight customers are now being served and that no more than one or two will be added within the foreseeable future. It is alleged that the utility is currently operating at a loss and that funds are not available for the installation of a second source or for the resulting operating expenses.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that the request is reasonable. The Commission concludes that the decision should be modified as set forth below.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 64983 is modified by deleting therefrom the words "or within one year after the date service is first rendered to the public under the authority herein granted, whichever is earlier,".

In all other respects Decision No. 64983 shall remain in full force and effect.
