ORDER AMENDING DECISIONAND DENYING REHEARING

Southern Pacific Company having petitioned for rehearing of Decision No. 68463, the Commission having considered each and every allegation of said petition, and being of the opinion that said decision should be amended, but that no good cause for rehearing has been shown;

IT IS ORDERED that the last sentence of the first paragraph of Decision No. 68463 is amended to read as follows:

Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-D) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material, and one boulevard stop sign on the bay side of the crossing.

Rehearing of Decision No. 68463, as amended by this order, is hereby denied.
