ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 55575 dated September 17, 1957, in Application No. 39324, Wilde and Wilde, Inc. was granted a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between the Southern Pacific Depot in the city of Fresno and the Southern Pacific Yard Office in the vicinity of Fresno; that, on December 1, 1964 the City of Fresno through annexation of an adjacent area, extended its corporate limits so that they now fully encompass the route over which authorized bus service is operated by Wilde and Wilde, Inc; and that by letter dated January 28, 1965, Wilde and Wilde, Inc. requested authority to withdraw from the jurisdiction of this Commission pursuant to pertinent provisions contained in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code;

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 55575 in

Application No. 39324, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Wilde and Wilde, Inc. are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
