ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 68097 dated October 20, 1964, in this proceeding provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of V. R. Anderson because he failed to have on file with the Commission the proper and lawful freight classification. That decision also provided that the effective date of the order would be stayed in the event he filed with the Commission before such effective date a written request for public hearing.

On October 28, 1964, the attorney for V. R. Anderson filed a written request for public hearing thereby staying the effective date of the order.

On December 8, 1964, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, filed Supplement 11 listing V. R. Anderson as a participant in National Motor Freight Classification A-7 (CAL) effective February 10, 1965. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 68097, supra, will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68097 dated October 20, 1964, in Application No. 35955 is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
