SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraphs 4 and 5 of Decision No. 67719, dated August 18, 1964, require applicants to effect specified plant improvements.

By letter dated December 30, 1964, applicants' manager has requested modification of these requirements. In lieu of the installation of a booster pump and approximately 1,700 feet of main, it is proposed to install a new source of supply and approximately 1,600 feet of main over a different route. An extension of time is requested for the installation of the facilities.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that the request is reasonable. The Commission concludes that the decision should be modified as set forth below.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraphs 4 and 5 of Decision No. 67719 are deleted therefrom and that the following paragraphs are added thereto:

4. On or before May 1, 1965, applicants shall install and place in operation an additional source of water supply in the vicinity of Jackson Street, capable of producing an adequate supply

of potable water for their West Riverbank system, and shall notify the Commission in writing of the details thereof within ten days thereafter.

5. On or before August 1, 1965, applicants shall install and place in operation approximately 1,000 feet of 8-inch pipe on Jackson Street from the foregoing new source of supply to the alley north of the Sonora Lateral, and approximately 600 feet of 6-inch pipe on Ross Avenue from the foregoing new 8-inch pipe to Howard Avenue, and shall notify the Commission in writing within ten days thereafter.

6. On or before May 1, 1966, applicants shall install and place in operation approximately 1,650 feet of 6-inch cement-asbestos pipe on Roselle Avenue between Ward Avenue and Talbot Avenue, and approximately 1,800 feet of 4-inch cement-asbestos pipe on Santa Fe Street between Claus Road and Snedigar Avenue, and shall notify the Commission in writing within ten days thereafter.

In all other respects Decision No. 67719 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
