O P I N I O N

Hulsman Transportation Co., a corporation, presently operating as a highway common carrier between various points within the State, requests that its operating authority be amended by deleting therefrom the transportation of fertilizer.

It is alleged that the commodity is exempt from minimum rate regulations and applicant, because it must file a tariff rate, cannot adjust its rates with the expediency that a permitted carrier can to satisfy shipper demands.

After consideration, the Commission finds that such request is not adverse to the public interest and concludes that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 52262, dated November 22, 1955, in Application No. 36343, as heretofore amended, is further amended by incorporating therein Second Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of First Revised Page 1.

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Fulsman Transportation Co. shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
