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Hulsman Transportation Co., a corporation, presently operating as a highway comon carrier between various points within the State, requests that its operating authority be amended by deleting therefrom the transportation of fextilizer.

It is alleged that the comodity is exempt from minimum rate zegulations and appiicant, because it must file a tariff rate, cannot edjust its rates with the expediency that a permitted carrier can to satisfy shipper demands.

After consideration, the Comission finds that such request is not adverse to the public interest and concludes that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.
