SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. **68687** entered today in Case No. 5432, et al., the Commission found that certain changes in Items Nos. 360 and 375 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and in certain items of Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be made. The order therein amended Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 and the Commission found that in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended by separate order.

The changes which will be ordered herein are for the purpose of clarification and will not result in any change in the minimum rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D of Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 10, 1965, the revised pages

attached hereto and listed in Appendix A also attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
