ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 58954 dated September 1, 1959 in Application No. 40967 and by Decision No. 64881 dated February 5, 1963 in Application No. 44876, Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. was granted passenger stage operative rights authorizing service between Hayward, Palma Ceia Village and Russell City and intermediate points and between the Hayward High School and the Fairview District in the vicinity of the city of Hayward; that, during the month of December 1963 it discontinued these services; that, by Decision No. 66570 dated January 7, 1964 in Application No. 45945, Emil H. Miller Transit Line was authorized to suspend operations for a period of one year, commencing January 27, 1964; that, since December 28, 1963 it has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage as required by General Order No. 101-A; that an investigation made on January 29, 1965 revealed that the service had not been resumed; and that Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. has not indicated, by the filing of timetables, tariffs or other notice, that it intends to restore service.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 58954 in Application No. 40967 and by Decision No. 64881 in Application No. 44876, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. or to mail a certified copy thereof to Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. at 912 Pacific Avenue, Santa Cruz, California, c/o Santa Cruz Transit Co., last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 20th day after such service upon Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. or after the above mailing to Emil H. Miller Transit Line, Inc. as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written responses to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
