Application of the State of California,
 Department of Public Works, for an order
 authorizing construction of a crossing
 at separated grades whereby State Route
 5 (old Route 7) will be carried over the
 tracks of the Southern Pacific Company
 in the County of Glenn, referred to as
 "West Willows Overhead".

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to construct State Route 5 (old Route 7, U.S. 99W) at separated grades over a spur track of Southern Pacific Company, near the City of Willows, Glenn County, referred to as West Willows Overhead, at the location and substantially as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AE-151.7-AC. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with requirements of General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction of the West Willows Overhead, a clearance of 21' 0" above top of rail is authorized provided Southern Pacific Company issue appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time

be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
