ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Terminal Storage Corporation has been suspended since June 25, 1964, for failure to maintain a tariff in effect. The tariff of this warehouseman was canceled by its tariff publishing agent effective April 15, 1964, and it has not filed the required tariff since that date.

Terminal Storage Corporation not having the required tariff on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman granted to Terminal Storage Corporation by Decision No. 64698 dated December 20, 1962, in Application No. 44944 is hereby revoked.

The certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizes service as a public utility warehouseman at Goleta.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Terminal Storage Corporation or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Terminal Storage Corporation or after the above mailing to Terminal Storage Corporation, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
