ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

The warehouse prescriptive operative right of Howard T. Johnston, doing business as California Seed & Fertilizer Co., has been suspended since November 12, 1964, for failure to maintain a tariff in effect. The tariff of this warehouseman was canceled by his tariff publishing agent effective October 15, 1964.

Howard T. Johnston, doing business as California Seed & Fertilizer Co., not having the required tariff on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the prescriptive right.

IT IS ORDERED that the public utility warehouse operative right possessed by Howard T. Johnston, doing business as California Seed & Fertilizer Co., as determined by the order of the Commission dated August 1, 1960, in Case No. 6728, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Howard T. Johnston or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

¹ The prescriptive operative right authorizes service as a public utility warehouseman at Yuba City and vicinity.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Howard T. Johnston or after the above mailing to Howard T. Johnston, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
