ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

The warehouse prescriptive operative right of Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz and Ray M. Goulart, doing business as C.F. Salz Co., has been suspended since November 11, 1964, for failure to maintain a tariff in effect.¹ The tariff of this warehouseman was canceled by the utility's tariff publishing agent effective October 1, 1964.

Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz and Ray M. Goulart not having the required tariff on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the prescriptive right.

IT IS ORDERED that the public utility warehouse operative right possessed by Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz and Ray M. Goulart as determined by the order of the Commission dated August 9, 1960, in Case No. 6758, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of certified copies of this order to be made upon Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz and Ray M. Goulart or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records.

¹ The prescriptive operative right authorizes service as a public utility warehouseman at Union City.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz or Ray M. Goulart or after the above mailing to Ida M. Silva, Manuel Muniz and Ray M. Goulart, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
