

applicants propose to operate under the fictitious firm name of A-1 Transfer and Moving Co.; applicant Arthur J. Lawson has had several years' experience in the business of transporting household goods; the financial condition of applicants, reflected in their application, shows adequate financial resources and responsibility.

Based upon the evidence, the Commission finds facts as hereinabove set forth and concludes that applicants possess the requisite qualifications to perform the services of a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that on the effective date of this decision the Secretary of the Commission shall cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 19-58062 to be issued to Arthur J. Lawson and Marcelle Matlock, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicants' operation (a) to an area within a 50-mile radius of the Los Angeles City Hall, and (b) to service performed only on an hourly- or piece-rate basis.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
