ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Moses Meiselman, doing business as Mann Trucking Co., to operate as a highway common carrier was suspended effective September 5, 1963, for failure to maintain the required classification and tariffs in effect. On September 5, 1963, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, filed tariff revisions listing Moses Meiselman, doing business as Mann Trucking Co., as a participant in various tariffs effective October 7, 1963. To date the carrier has not filed the required classification.

Moses Meiselman not having the required classification on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Moses Meiselman, an individual, doing business as Mann Trucking Co., by Decision No. 53447, dated July 16, 1956, in Application No. 37726, is hereby revoked.


2. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Moses Meiselman, an individual, doing business as Mann Trucking Co., from its tariffs on file with this Commission, said cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Moses Meiselman or to mail a certified copy thereof to Moses Meiselman at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Moses Meiselman or after the above mailing to Moses Meiselman, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
