O P I N I O N

Members of the Commission staff having determined after written examination as provided in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, and a study of his application, that David Louie is qualified to operate under a household goods carrier permit with the restrictions hereinafter stated, the matter was set for hearing in San Francisco on February 16, 1965, before Examiner Rowe.

Evidence introduced at the hearing shows that applicant was given an examination on December 17, 1964, and was graded below the passing grade of 80 percent for the entire examination but a passing grade was obtained on that portion of said examination pertaining to hourly rates. The staff witness who gave the examination testified that in his opinion applicant was qualified to perform service charging hourly rates only and restricted to transportation in San Francisco, City and County, and within fifty miles beyond the border of said City and County. The staff also was of the opinion that applicant's proposal to use a stake truck in this movement was inadequate. It was stipulated that applicant would acquire a new van-type Chevrolet truck, which was considered appropriate for use in such service with the above-stated restrictions.

Based upon the evidence and the stipulation, the Commission finds that applicant has sufficient experience, financial ability and equipment to perform the services herein authorized. It concludes that applicant should be authorized to perform services as a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that on the effective date of this order the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 38-7953 to be issued to David Louie, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operations (a) to an area within a 50-mile radius of the City and County of San Francisco and (b) to service in a van-type truck only on an hourly basis.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
