Charles R. Wood requests authority to sell and transfer, and Donald J. French and Jean P. French request avehority to purchase and acquire, operating authority as a pubite utilsty warehouseman.

The operating authority was described In Dectston No. 65777, dated Feb=uaxy II, IS64, In Application No. 46015, anc authorizes operations as a public utility waxehouseman for the storage of monperiskable comodities in 3,000 square feet of floor space at Vacaville, Califoraia. The agreed consiferotion Is $\$ 10$. As of November 30, 1964, appIicant purchasers Indicated a net worth in the amount of $\$ 150,350$.

After consideration the Comission finds tiant the proposed sale would not be adverse to the public interest. $A$ public bearing is not necessary.

The authorization heretn granted shaIl not be construed as a findiag of the value of the rights and properties herein authorized to be transferred.
ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:
I. On or before July I, 1965, Charles R. Wood may selI and traxsfer, and Donald J. French and Jean P. French may purchase and acquire, the operative rights referred to in the applicetion.
2. Within thirty days after the consumation of the transfer herein authorized, Lonaid J. French and Jean P. French shall notify the Commission in writing of that fact and within said perioc shail file with the Comission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect sald transfer.
3. Donald J. French and Jean P. French shail amend or relssue the taxiffs on file with the Commission, naming rates and rules governing the warehouse operations herein to show that they lave adopeed or established, as their own, said rates and ruies. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days. after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days? zotice to the Comission and che public, and the effectlve cate of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfex herein authorized. The tariff filings made prizsuant to this order shall comply in all respects whth the regulatoons goveraing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Comission's General Order No. 6I-A.

4. On or before the end of the third month after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, Donald J. French and Jean P. French shall cause to be filed with the Commission in such form as it may prescribe an annual report, or reports, covering the period commencing with the first day of the current year to and including the effective date of the transfer.
