## OPINION

Charles R. Wood requests authority to sell and transfer, and Donald J. French and Jean P. French request authority to purchase and acquire, operating authority as a public utility warehouseman.

The operating authority was described in Decision No. 65777, dated February 11, 1964, in Application No. 46015, and authorizes operations as a public utility warehouseman for the storage of nonperishable commodities in 3,000 square feet of floor space at Vacaville, California. The agreed consideration is \$10. As of November 30, 1964, applicant purchasers indicated a net worth in the amount of \$150,350.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed sale would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the rights and properties herein authorized to be transferred.

4. On or before the end of the third month after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, Donald J. French and Jean P. French shall cause to be filled with the Commission in such form as it may prescribe an annual report, or reports, covering the period commencing with the first day of the current year to and including the effective date of the transfer.
