O P I N I O N

P. C. Fredericksen, Mildred Sue Kreutzer, as executrix of the estate of H. C. Fredericksen, and Vivian E. Fredericksen, as administratrix of the estate of Laurel M. Fredericksen, request authority to transfer and P. C. Fredericksen, Kenneth Fredericksen, Vivian E. Fredericksen, Crystal F. Adamson, Lorn W. Fredericksen and Virginia F. Eisenbeisz request authority to acquire certain partnership property including a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products, in tank trucks and tank trailers, as a petroleum irregular route carrier. Said certificate was acquired by Decision No. 50100 dated June 1, 1954, in Application No. 35429.

It is alleged that H. C. Fredericksen died May 17, 1962 and that Laurel M. Fredericksen died February 26, 1961; and that pursuant to probate proceedings their partnership interests have passed to their heirs who are now members of the partnership and applicant transferees herein.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On or before December 1, 1965, P. C. Fredericksen, Mildred Sue Krcutzex, as executrix of the estate of H. C. Fredericksen, and Vivian E. Fredericksen, as administratrix of the estate of Laurel M. Fredericksen, may transfer, and P. C. Fredericksen, Kenneth Fredericksen, Vivian E. Fredericksen, Crystal F. Adamson, Lorn W. Fredericksen and Virginia F. Eisenbeisz may acquire, the operative rights and property referred to in the application.

2. Within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, P. C. Fredericksen, Kenneth Fredericksen, Vivian E. Fredericksen, Crystal F. Adamson, Lorn W. Fredericksen and Virginia F. Eisenbeisz shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.

3. P. C. Fredericksen, Kenneth Fredericksen, Vivian E. Fredericksen, Crystal F. Adamson, Lorn W. Fredericksen and Virginia F. Eisenbeisz shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations herein to show that they have adopted or established, as their own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the

effective day of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80-A.

4. On or before the end of the third month after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, P.C. Fredericksen, Kenneth Fredericksen, Vivian E. Fredericksen, Crystal F. Adamson, Lorn W. Fredericksen and Virginia F. Eisenbeisz shall cause to be filed with the Commission, in such form as it may prescribe, an annual report, or reports, covering the period commencing with the first day of the current year to and including the effective date of the transfer.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
