Application of the County of Yolo
to relocate Grade Crossing AF-93.6,
County Road 116, across the right-
of-way of the Southern Pacific
Railroad Company. }

O R D E R

County of Yolo is hereby authorized to relocate the crossing of County Road No. 116 at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, at Knights Landing, Yolo County, the relocated crossing to be identified as Crossing No. AF-93.5, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Upon completion, existing Crossing No. AF-93.6 about eighty feet northerly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
