ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across the unimproved roadways of Taft Avenue and 12th Street in the City of National City, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. 36B-4.85-C and 36B-4.88-C, respectively.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense of the crossings. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72, and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
