In the matter of the Application of Dominic A. Mannino DBA M & M Charter Lines to operate passenger stage service via School type buses to schools located in the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District.

Application No. 47296 (Filed January 26, 1965)

<u>OPINION</u>

Applicant is presently authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation and a charter party carrier. By this application it proposed to establish a school bus service within an area in the Palos. Verdes peninsula bounded on the north by Pacific Coast Highway and Avenue I (Redondo Beach), on the east by Western Avenue and on the south and west by the Pacific Ocean. All the schools are a part of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District. The service has been requested by the school board.

Service will be provided on authorized school days only and is for school children desiring round trip transportation.

Bus schedules will correspond with those set by the Palos Verdes School Board for each respective school and will be subject to changes as required.

Proposed round trip monthly fares are \$7.00 for the first child, \$6.00 for the second child, and \$5.00 for the third child in a family, with maximum of \$18.00 per family per month, regardless of the number of children.

The proposed service is not competitive with that of any other carrier. The application is not opposed.

- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

and certain territories intermediate thereto, over and along the route hereinafter described, subject to the conditions and restrictions hereinafter set forth:

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction unless otherwise indicated.

Route 28:

Los Angeles-Santa Anita Race Track
Commencing at the intersection of Vermont and
Manchester Avenues, thence along Manchester Avenue,
Firestone Boulevard, Compton Avenue, Florence Avenue,
Atlantic Boulevard and Huntington Drive to entrance of
race track.
