ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Baker & Stanton, Inc., a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of new and used household goods and related property between Eureka and various points in northern California.

George A. Baker, President of Baker & Stanton, Inc., has informed the Commission by letter that the corporation ceased operations as a highway common carrier on June 30, 1964.

Baker & Stanton, Inc., having discontinued service as a highway common carrier without proper authority, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such discontinuance constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity involved and the tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Baker & Stanton, Inc., by Decision No. 52960 dated April 24, 1956, in Application No. 37617, as amended, is hereby revoked.

2. Baker & Stanton, Inc., Local Freight Tariffs Nos. 2 and 3, Cal.P.U.C. Nos. 2 and 3 (Series of George A. Baker, doing business as Baker and Stanton Transfer and Storage Co.), are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Baker & Stanton, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Baker & Stanton, Inc., or after the above mailing to Baker & Stanton, Inc., as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
