ORDER VACATING ORDER OF  
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The petroleum irregular route carrier certificate of public convenience and necessity of R. H. Morrison has been under suspension since January 24, 1965, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required tariffs. The suspension was effected by Decision No. 68408, dated December 30, 1964, in this proceeding.

On February 24, 1965, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, filed a tariff revision reinstating R. H. Morrison as a participant in the tariffs involved effective March 29, 1965. Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 68408, supra, will be vacated.
