## QPINION

Applicant seeks a permit as a cement contract carricr. The application requests rights in all of Califomia north of the Telnachapis. Public hearing was held before Examiner Power at San Francisco on September 24, 1964. At the hearing applicant reduced the request to 20 counties in which he claimed to have rendered service. Protestants included four highway carriezs and a railroad. All are prime carriers.

Applicant filed this application on Janary 20,29640 Ead he filed in time (on or before December 30, 1963) and on the correce form he would have obtained "grandfathez" rights. His tostimony and his application both agree that he comenced operations in April of 1962 and operated continuously thereafter.

Applicant's tractor is fully paid for and is kept in a safe, worikable condition. His business headquarters is in the Warm Springs section of Fremont. His application indicates a personal net worth of $\$ 8,34,5$.

After consideration，the Commission finds that：
1．Applicant possesses the ability and financial responsibility to provide the proposed operation．

2．The proposed operation will not endanger the safety of the public nor interfere with the public use of the highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them directly or indirectly．

3．The proposed operation will not impair the service of previously certificated cement carriers or permitted cement contract carriers．

4．Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive such permit to operate as a cement contract carrier．

The commission concludes that the application should be granted．

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IT IS ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission shall issue a cement contract carrier permit to Jess Anthony Bettencourt authorizing operations from any or all points of origin to all points Tiさんi上 the Counties of alameda，Butte，Contra Costa，Fresno； Kern，Merced，Monterey，Napa，Nevada，Placer，Sacramento，San Benito， San Francisco，San Joaquin，San Mateo，Santa Clara，Solano，Sonoma， and Tuolume．

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof．
