OPINION

A duly noticed public hearing was held before Examiner Power at Los Angeles on February 24, 1965 and the matter was submitted.

One cement company and a group of six carriers protested. Three cement companies appeared as interested parties.

As the evidence developed, the protesting cement company's representative changed its appearance to that of an interested party. Counsel for the carrier protestants did not change their appearance.

The evidence revealed that Harris has been in the trucking business since 1946. He had been transporting cement for about five
