ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application is a request of Pacific Air Lines, Inc., (Pacific) for authority to cancel its Local Passenger Fares Tariff No. D-1, which contains so-called "Department of Defense" (DOD) fares.

By letter dated March 26, 1965, applicant has informed the Commission that said fares were established and canceled pursuant to negotiation between applicant and the Department of Defense (Headquarters, Military Air Transport Service, USAF, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois) under statutory procurement procedures established by the Congress of the United States.

Pacific has filed a cancellation notice as a supplement to its Local Passenger Fares Tariff No. D-1; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled application is dismissed.
