A petition for rehearing of Decision 68682 amending Decision 66482 having been filed by Boulevard Transportation Co., et al., and the Commission having determined that the Interstate Commerce Act, subsection 206(a)(6) (Public Law 87-805; 76 Stat. 911, Section 206(a); 49 U.S.C.A. 306(a)(6)) provides for reconsideration by the Interstate Commerce Commission of the Commission's decision herein respecting the authorization of operations in interstate commerce, which is the only issue raised by petitioners; and being of the opinion that that section gives the Interstate Commerce Commission exclusive jurisdiction to entertain such petition for rehearing;

IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby dismissed.
