O P I N I O N

Richard L. Cademartori, doing business as R. L. Cademartori Trucking Co., requested that his certificated authority as a highway common carrier be either suspended or revoked.

The operating authority was acquired by applicant by Decision No. 50585, dated September 28, 1954, in Application No. 35457. Said certificate authorizes the transportation of fresh fruits, and vegetables, including melons, fresh potatoes and fresh onions in boxes from the Delta Region of the Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers to the commission and brokerage markets of San Francisco and Oakland, and to the canneries in said market districts and for the return movement of empty containers from said districts of San Francisco and Oakland to points within the said Delta Region.

It is alleged that at one time the majority of fresh fruits and vegetables were sold through the commission houses located in San Francisco and Oakland, but with the advent of the supermarkets, such as Safeway Stores, Louis Stores, Lucky Stores, who not only maintain their own warehouses, but provide their own transportation, the practice has changed so that the movement within the certificated territory of applicant has practically ceased.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a highway common carrier. The certificate will be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Richard L. Cademartori may discontinue service as a highway common carrier and the operating authority acquired by Decision No. 50585, dated September 28, 1954, in Application No. 35457 is hereby revoked.

2. Local Freight Tariff No. 2 on file with the Commission in the name of Richard L. Cademartori is hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
