## OPINION

George Kishida requests authority to transfer a certificate authorizing operations as a cement carrier to George Kishida, Inc., a newly formed corporation.

The authority was granted by Resolution No.13825, Sub. No. 44, dated June 23, 1964. As of December 31, 1964, the corporation indicated a net worth in the amount of \$134,778.02.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. For the purpose of better establishing and maintaining records the operating authority will be revoked and restated in a new certificate. The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of said certificate. A public hearing is not necessary.

George Kishida, Inc. is hereby placed on notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an element of value in rate fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originally paid to the State as the consideration for the grant of such rights. Aside from their purely permissive aspect, such rights extend to the holder a full or partial monopoly of a class of business over a particular route. This monopoly feature may be modified or canceled at any time by the State, which is not in any respect limited as to the number of rights which may be given.

3. Concurrent with the effective date of the tariff filings required by ordering paragraph 2(b) hereof the operating authority described by Commission Resolution No. 13825, Sub. No. 44, dated June 23, 1964, is hereby revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
