ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant operates as a highway contract carrier and a city carrier. By this application, as amended, he sought authority to transport newsprint for Southwest Forest Industries from the Santa Fe dock at 2050 East Washington Boulevard to the premises of the Los Angeles Herald Examiner at 1111 South Hill Street, both in the City of Los Angeles, at a rate of 10 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 40,000 pounds. Said rate would constitute a deviation from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5.

Public hearing of the application was held before Examiner Bishop at Los Angeles on March 31, 1965. An adjourned hearing was scheduled for April 12, 1965 for the completion of cross-examination of applicant and the presentation of evidence
